

Code of Conduct

As a member of the Central Coast Table Tennis Association, CCTTA, you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during any activity held or sanctioned by the CCTTA and in your role as a player / participant in any activity held by or under the auspices of the CCTTA:

- Be fair, considerate and respects the rights of fellow players. Refrain from any behaviour that may bring the CCTTA into disrepute.
- Do not use your involvement with the CCTTA to promote your own beliefs, behaviours or practices where these are inconsistent with those of the CCTTA.
- Care for and respect the equipment provided to you as part of your program.
- Conduct yourself in a professional manner relating to language, temper and punctuality. Refrain from any form of harassment of others.
- Abide by the rules and respect the decision of the official, making all appeals through the formal process and respecting the final decision.

Breaching any part of this code may result in a player being given a verbal or written warning from the committee.

For more severe cases a player will be withdrawn from play and that player will not recommence play until the CCTTA committee has adjudicated on the incident. Involved players may be asked to appear before the committee.
